Who We Are

Teknion is an international designer, manufacturer and marketer of office systems and related products, including storage and filing, seating, casegoods, tables and ergonomic furniture. Teknion's corporate headquarters are based in Toronto. U.S. headquarters are in Mount Laurel, New Jersey, and the European head office is located in London.

Employee Base/Facilities

Established in 1981, Teknion now employs 3,700 people worldwide and has approximately three million square feet of facilities, including manufacturing plants, showrooms, corporate headquarters and sales offices. The company operates 16 manufacturing facilities in Ontario, four in Quebec, two in Alberta, one in Stewartville, Minnesota, and three in Malaysia.

Product Line/Distribution

The introduction in 1983 of Teknion's flexible and configurable T/O/S office system helped transform the furniture industry. Today, the company's extensive product line is sold in more than 50 countries through a network of more than 385 authorized dealers. Teknion has a growing North American market presence and continues to expand into South and Central America, the Caribbean, Pacific Rim, Asia and Europe.

Funding

In fiscal 2001, Teknion's sales were \$770.9 million. The company went public on July 10, 1998. Teknion's shares are listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol TKN.

Company Growth

Teknion completed an expansion announced in 2001 by adding more than 700,000 square feet of manufacturing, showroom and office space, significantly increasing production capacity and the ability to meet customer needs. Part of this expansion was the new U.S. corporate office, showroom, marketing and design center in New Jersey.
