**TEKNION LAUNCHES MARINI
EXECUTIVE TASK CHAIR AT NEOCON 2009**

CHICAGO, June 15, 2009 – Teknion Corporation announced today the introduction of its Marini Executive Task Chair at NeoCon, June 15 to 17, at The Merchandise Mart in Chicago.

“Marini is a high-performance executive task chair synonymous with a high level of style, performance, quality and luxury,” said Kees Breeuwsma, Teknion Vice President of Seating. “With its refined level of design, Marini delivers exceptional comfort and performance for the business professional in private office and boardroom settings.”

Marini is highly adjustable to accommodate personal preferences, task requirements, as well as varying body sizes and shapes of the business professional. When assuming normal working postures, the backrest remains in contact with the user's lumbar area throughout the range of back reclination. Marini's back frame – over-molded with comfort foam – helps provide maximum personalized lumbar and back support and complete comfort.

The seat has been designed with molded comfort foam to help distribute weight, thereby alleviating pressure and avoiding “bottoming out” while seated. Three cylinder styles provide seat-height adjustment ranges for 3, 4 and 5 inches to allow the user to adjust the height to suit their individual size and preference. A 2 1/2-inch seat depth adjustment allows the user to ensure proper contact with the chair back, helping reduce pressure behind the knees. The adjustment also corresponds with varying buttock to popliteal area (inside knee) dimensions.

Marini's tension control feature is easy to adjust from a seated position and tailors the chair's tilt resistance to accommodate personal size, weight and preference. Marini is available with height- and width-adjustable T-arms. The polished or powder-coated aluminum base is fitted with 60mm hard or soft casters.

Teknion's new executive task chair was designed by Conrad Marini, the well-known international designer and developer of successful products for major North American and European office furniture companies. Marini is also the founder and Director of the CMM Design Associates studio located outside of Toronto.

Marini incorporates materials that have a low impact on the environment to help protect the world's ecology. The chair's modular design allows for easy replacement of parts and aids

end-of-life recycling or disposal. Over 90 percent of the chair is recyclable. Marini is Greenguard Certified for indoor air quality, and manufactured in facilities certified to the ISO 14001 environmental management system.

In addition to the Marini Executive Task Chair, Teknion will be showcasing its Visio Task Chair and Sitara Side Chair at NeoCon. Also on display in Teknion's tenth-floor showroom are the new Optos Curved Wall and Altos Acoustic Fascia, W/R/S Wall Rail System, fx accessories and PolyBamboo seating fabrics.
