ABOUT DOORS OPEN DENVER:

Doors Open Denver is an annual celebration of Denver's built environment and design. The two-day event allows residents and visitors to tour the spectacular buildings they see every day but may never have entered. It allows the public to truly experience and develop a new appreciation for their home town and the facilities that comprise Denver's rich architectural landscape. It also helps build a sense of community by opening up the doors of Denver to everyone.

2011 EVENT DATES: April 16th and 17th

TICKET PRICE: Free

EVENT DETAILS: Every year approximately 80 buildings open their doors to the public. Some examples of participating sites have included: the Presidential Suite at the Brown Palace Hotel, the Daniels & Fisher Tower on the 16th Street Mall, and backstage at the Ellie Caulkins Opera House.

An additional number of expert guided tours (approximately 100) are also available to the public. Examples include the Historic City Park Tour, Denver After Dark Tour, Mayan Theatre Tour and a Historic LODO Tour.

ATTENDANCE & DEMOGRAPHICS:

Approximately 55,000 people participate in Doors Open Denver every year. As a city-wide free event, Doors Open Denver appeals to a broad range of people. Participants include families with children who want to explore their city, college students looking for an inexpensive way to spend a day, retired adults interested in architecture, and many others. The event primarily attracts Denver Metro area residents.

EVENT PRODUCERS:

The Denver Architectural Foundation is a 501 (c)3 non-profit organization whose mission is to increase public awareness and appreciation for architecture and its influence on our quality of life through education, participation, and advocacy for excellence. Because this event is an important initiative of the Mayor's Office, the Denver Office of Cultural Affairs also supports it with staff time and funding.
